INFORMATION DURING YOUR EXAMS

- Be on time for all of your exams. Aim to arrive at least 15 minutes before the stated time. There is a lot to do.

Make sure that you have a good breakfast. Food will be served in the Dining Room from 8.15 am if you have a morning exam. Vouchers will be provided by your subject teacher.



Please leave any valuables at home.

Mobile Phones- Students must not have a mobile phone, Apple watch or other electronic device in their possession-whether it is turned on or off.

This is very important. You could be disqualified at least from the exam, if not all exams with that board. Phones must be handed in or left at home.

Remember all the equipment that you need. You will need to bring a **BLACK** ball point pen (carry a spare also), pencil, eraser, ruler and any other special equipment you need such as calculators and maths equipment. You will need to have these in a **CLEAR** pencil case or clear plastic bag.



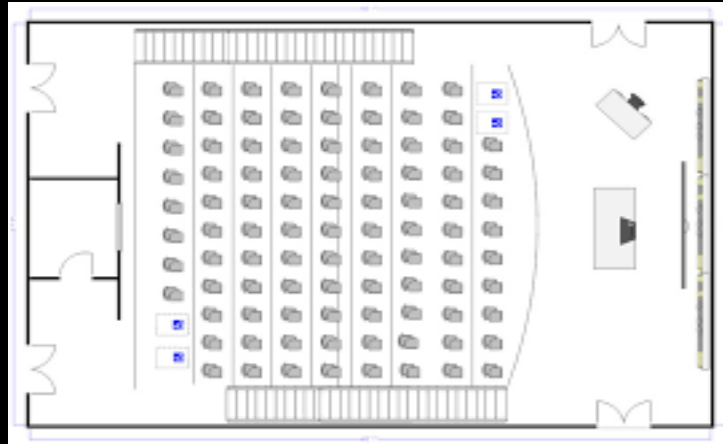
A seating plan will be displayed outside the examination room and inside the Dining Room.

When you enter the examination room there should be no talking or communication between students.

Please find your seat quickly and quietly, putting all your equipment needed for the exam on the desk.

If you need assistance then raise your hand and an invigilator will come to you.





Full uniform must be worn.

Bottled water will be provided by the School for all exams. You are not permitted to bring your own drinks into the exam room.

Listen carefully to the instructions and notices read out by invigilators. Make sure that you have the correct exam paper before you start.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q. What is the school centre number?

This is 30165 and will be displayed clearly at the front of the exam room.

Q. What if I feel unwell before/during an exam?

If you are not well on the day of an exam, contact the school as soon as possible, so that we can give you the best advice for your situation. If you feel unwell during an exam, let an invigilator know and they will help you.

Q. Can I take the exam on a different day?

No. The times and dates regulated by the exam boards cannot be changed.

Q. Do I have to wear uniform?

Yes. Normal school regulations apply for uniform, hair, jewellery and make-up etc. Failure to follow normal regulations may result in you being removed from the Examination room.
