



Y11 Exam period information

Dear Parent/Guardian

I would like to take this opportunity to provide you with information regarding the start of the summer Year 11 exams.

The main exams start from the 15th May 2017. Students will be in normal lessons (if they are not in exams) for the entirety of period between the 15th May and 26th May. Even if students have an exam during this time they need to make their way to their next lesson after as has happened in previous years. Students are not given permission to leave the school site or go home during this period of the exams.

After half term (5th June) students will only need to be in school for their exams and revision sessions. They are therefore allowed to leave school following morning and afternoon exams. This allows them to prepare for their next exam. We are pleased to say this right has been awarded Year 11 because of their good behaviour during the March mock period. The Learning Centre in school will be available for those students who wish to remain in school to revise at this time.

As we have done with all of our practice exams, students should arrive at least fifteen minutes before the start of their exam to ensure they know their seat number; this will be displayed in the dining room, outside the sports hall and also outside the main hall.

A timetable has been included with the report and shows breakfast, after school and day time revision for students for the exam period. Saturday school continues over the exam period and we would encourage students to make the most of this facility.

We will be sending our final letter for Year 11 students over the next few weeks. This will continue information regarding the prom and the leavers' assembly. We aim to answer frequently asked questions in this letter.
