Students' safety when crossing roads

As you may be aware, we are currently without a crossing patrol by the lower school gate on the Littleworth Road. I have been in touch with the Safer Roads Partnership at Staffordshire County Council to enquire about the patrol and am informed that there is currently no relief available and that there is no certainty that a replacement will be provided.

I would like to ask you to take this opportunity to remind your child(ren) about the importance of being very careful when crossing roads at all times including when walking to and from school. In particular, when in groups they must continue be aware of and give way to traffic and not simply follow others and cross in large groups in front of oncoming vehicles. I will ensure that this reminder is also given regularly through the student notices in school.

Aerosol Sprays

We have recently had a couple of incidents in school where aerosols, particularly deodorant sprays have been used inappropriately. This can be very dangerous for asthma sufferers or if sprayed into someone's eyes. For this reason we ask that students do not bring deodorant sprays into school. We are very happy for them to bring roll-on deodorants for use after PE lessons.
