

GCSE Maths Re-sits

Dear parent/carer,

As your son/daughter did not achieve a Grade 4 in the summer GCSE exams he/she is required to retake GCSE Mathematics in November.

A minimum of Grade 4 is required for entry into almost all work placements, colleges and universities and re-sitting GCSE Maths is a compulsory statutory requirement up until the age of 18 if a Grade 4 was not achieved at the end of Year 11. Therefore, your son/daughter will attend Year 11 classes that are currently running in order to be prepared for their upcoming examinations in November. They will need to check the schedule below and identify the four periods across the fortnight that they are able to attend due to other timetabled lessons. Sessions will begin from 16th September and will be at the following times:
