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Careers Advice and Support for Parents

Here is a list of useful websites and information that will support you in helping your child with regards to their next steps:

- Prospects – The Prospects website highlights lots of key information about a wide range of careers including the responsibilities, skills and most importantly, qualifications needed to get into this job: <https://www.prospects.ac.uk/job-profiles>
- National Careers Service – Similarly, the National Careers Service has information on different careers and the requirements needed, but you can also search to see where different courses are taught: <https://nationalcareers.service.gov.uk/>
- UCAS – The UCAS website allows you to search for all the different university courses available. If your child is considering going to university in the future, it is worthwhile looking at some entry requirements to see if they need specific subjects at A-Level. For example, if your child is looking to study Law in the future, A-level English and History are sometimes required by specific universities: <https://wwwucas.com/explore/search>

- Apprenticeships – The Gov.uk website is a great place for students to be searching for apprenticeships and the application forms. Students have been encouraged to look at the applications for apprenticeships and to be preparing themselves by making a start on their CV: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-apprenticeship>
